Because Work Experience Education is highly regulate by Federal, State and District laws and regulations it is necessary that both student and parents understand these law and regulations.

Classroom Rules:

- Respect School and Personal Property.
- No Food or Drinks in Classroom.
- Bring Appropriate Materials to Class.

Class Requirements:

- State Law requires students to attend class sessions once a week. A student attending less than 60% of the classes from the date they were enrolled will result in an "F" and no credits earned.
- If a student is absent from class they must make it up by going to Mr. Reedy's website, printing out a makeup assignment and turning it in the following week. A student can makeup five (5) assignments maximum. NO late makeup assignments will be accepted.
- Make up assignments do not count toward the 60% attendance rule.
- Student must maintain regular attendance in ALL classes. (NO Truants or Suspensions)
- Satisfactory grades in all classes. (NO F's)
- Student will be placed on Work Experience probation for any F's
- Student may be dropped from Work Experience and could loose their Work Experience Work Permit if they continue to fail any classes.
- Attending 18 classes and turning in 200 work hours will earn the student a maximum of 10 credits per semester.
- Attending 18 classes, completing all assignments, and a passing Employee Evaluation will earn the student a passing letter grade.
- Student must turn in all required enrollment forms for Work Experience or risk being dropped from the class. (Training Agreement [goldenrod] and Individual Training Plan [blue])
- **The attached sheet explains why a student in Work Experience Education would get a progress report or failing/low quarter grade.**

*Non compliance of classroom rules or class requirements will result in disciplinary action and the possibility of the student being dropped from the class with an **F grade and no credit.***
